Guidelines for Admission in PG Courses:⇒

1.	➔ Only students who have passed UG course in the year 2023, 2024 and 2025 are eligible to apply for admission to the Post-Graduate Course for the academic session 2025-26.
2.	➔ Admission into the PG Courses: Bengali, Sanskrit, Geography, Philosophy & History will be made strictly on the basis of Merit List generated from UG Result
3.	➔ Online Applications from eligible candidates are invited for admission into 2 years (4 semesters) Post Graduate Regular Courses.
4.	➔ Online Application Forms for admission will be available from Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya website - www.bajkulcollege.org from 14.10.2025 (11:00 am) to 20.10.2025 (11:59 pm) .
5.	➔ No Application fee has to be paid online through Payment Gateway Mode (Credit Card/ Debit Card/ Net Banking/ Cash) through SBI Collect.
6.	➔ Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit of UG Examination Result. In the case of equal marks obtained in UG Examination, total marks / percentage of marks of immediately preceding Examination is to be taken into account for ranking.
7.	➔ As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal and also Vidyasagar University 80% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of V.U & autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University and 20% seats will be available for Open to all.
8.	➔ This 80% reserved seat will be filled according to the merit list(formed according to the obtained Hons. marks or equivalent in the concerned subject).
9.	➔ Quota for reserved category students will be provided as per latest Govt. order of West Bengal.
10.	➔ Date of e-Admission: - 22.10.2025 (7:00pm) & Onwards (Follow the Admission Schedule).

11.	➔ Online provisional admission will be done through the college admission portal. All e-admissions are provisional.
12.	➔ An admission is liable to be cancelled for submission of incorrect data or false statements.
13.	➔ The physical verification of testimonials & other documents for provisionally admitted students will be initiated as per notification.
14.	➔ The admission will be cancelled if a student remains absent in classes for consecutive 10 days from the date of commencement of classes.
15.	➔ All admissions will be made as per existing Reservation Policy of the State Government. The Candidates will have to produce SC/ST/OBC /PWD / EWS Certificates (If any) in original at the time of verification.
16.	➔ Migration Certificate (for other university candidate only) must be submitted within 07.11.2025.

Process of e-Admission Fees Refund:

A. In case of e-Admission cancellation/taking the release from the college

Candidate is interested to cancel his/ her e- Admission from the college, must submit/ deposit the application regarding the fact in web menu as '**Complain Box**' under PG e-Admission Portal.



Candidate must have to collect the cancellation receipt through the menu of 'Cancellation Receipt' (Cancellation Receipt will be generated within 72-hours from submit of application).



The candidate must submit a Hard copy of application letter in plain paper along with 'Admission Slip' and 'Cancellation Receipt' in the college office (except holidays) for return of admission fees.

N.B.: This is notified that the e-Admission Fees will be strictly refunded as per Govt. Order from the Cash Counter of the college office.
