Eligibility Criteria for the Admission to PG Courses in different disciplines-2019-'20:

Sl. No.	Criteria	Details
1.	The students passed out in the year 2018 & 2019 are only eligible for admission to the PG courses in Bengali, Sanskrit, Philosophy, History and Geography for the academic session 2019-20.	
2.	Bengali, History, Philosophy and Sanskrit (PG for Arts Discipline):	Honours in the concerned subject
3.	Geography & Environment Management (PG for Arts/ Science Discipline):	Honours in the relevant subject
4.	Eligible Obtained Marks for applying in M.A./ M.Sc. (Arts/ Science Subjects) of PG Course for Open Competition (40% of total seats):	45% for General Category (Unreserved/ UR) & 40% for Reserved Categories (SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B & PH)
5.	Eligible Obtained Marks for applying in M.A./ M.Sc. (Arts/ Science Subjects) of PG Course for the students of Vidyasagar University (60% of total seats):	Honours passed (40% in Honours subject) in concerned subjects for all categories of student

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION IN PG COURSES:⇒

1.	➔ Online Applications from eligible candidates are invited for admission into 2 years (4 semesters) Post Graduate Courses
2.	➔ Admission into the PG Courses: Bengali, Sanskrit, Geography, Philosophy & History will be made strictly on the basis of the result of Common Entrance Test (CET).
3.	➔ Online Application Forms for admission will be available from Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya website - www.bajkulcollege.org from 29.05.2019 to 17.06.2019.

4.	➔ Last date of e-payment of application fee - 17.06.2019 .
5.	➔ Application fee of Rs. 250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty) only has to be paid online through Payment Gateway Mode (Credit Card/ Debit Card/ Net Banking/ Cash) through SBI Collect.
6.	➔ Normally 60% seats will be for the students of the Vidyasagar University and 40% seats for other Open to all.
7.	➔ Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit of Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya. In the case of equal marks obtained in CET, total marks / percentage of marks of Honours is to be taken into account for ranking. In case of equal marks obtained in Honours immediately preceding Examination are to be considered for ranking.
8.	➔ As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal 60% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of V.U & autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University and 40% seats will be available for Open to all.
9.	➔ The 60% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for passed out Honours students of VU & autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University, which will be selected from the merit list of CET and the candidates have to obtain Hons marks or equivalent in the major subject.
10.	➔ Quota for SC/ ST will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn / Estt dated 18.09.1997. Number of seats (SC-22%, ST-6%, OBC-A-10%, OBC-B-7%) will be calculated and considered separately for 60% seats of V.U. students and 40% seats for Open Competition. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number.
11.	➔ Entrance Test in each subject will be based on prescribed Under Graduate (Honours) syllabus of Vidyasagar University.
12.	➔ Question paper of each subject contains 50 (Fifty) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ), each carrying 2 marks. Each MCQ will have 4 options.
13.	➔ Duration of Entrance Exam - 1 hour.
14.	➔ 0.5 mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
15.	➔ Questions will be set in English, except Bengali and Sanskrit.
16.	➔ At the time of Entrance Examination Candidate need to carry the Admit Card of PG Entrance Examination, Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya and must bring any photo identity proof (Ex: Voter Card, Pan Card, Aadhaar Card or UG 3 rd Year Admit Card).
17.	➔ Date of publication of Merit List (under both 60% & 40% category) for Open Competition: 04/07/2019
18.	➔ Date of e-Admission: - Date will be declared and available online in due time
19.	➔ Online provisional admission will be done through the college admission portal. All e-admissions are provisional.
20.	➔ An admission is liable to be cancelled for incorporation of incorrect data or false statements.
21.	➔ The verification of testimonials & other documents for provisionally admitted students will be initiated after commencement of classes.

22.	→ The verification will be held in the concerned department. The teachers of the concerned department will be present at the time of verification.
23.	→ The admission will be cancelled if a student remained absent from classes for consecutive 10 days from the date of commencement of classes without any intimation to the concerned head of the department or institution. The admission fees paid will not be refunded.
24.	→ If any candidate shifts to another institution without intimation to the authority of the institution within 10-days from the date of commencement of classes, the admission fees paid will not be refunded.
25.	→ If a student applies to the college authority for the cancellation of admission within 10-days from the date of commencement of classes, 10% of the total admission fees will be deducted as processing fee and the rest will be refunded to candidate.
26.	→ All admissions will be made as per existing Reservation Policy of the State Government. The Candidates will have to produce SC/ST/OBC/PWD Certificates in original at the time of Counselling.
27.	→ Migration Certificate (for other university candidate only) must be submitted within two months from the date of admission.
