	☐ GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION IN PG COURSES: ⇒
1.	→ Online Applications from eligible candidates are invited for admission into 2 years (4 semesters) Post Graduate Courses
2.	→ Admission into the PG Courses: Bengali, Sanskrit, Geography, Philosophy & History will be made strictly on the basis of the result of Common Entrance Test (CET).
3.	→ Online Application Forms for admission will be available from Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya website – www.bajkulcollege.org from 10.05.2018 to 09.06.2018.
4.	→ Last date of payment of application fee - 11.06.2018.
5.	→ Application fee of Rs. 250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty) only has to be paid online through Payment Gateway Mode (Credit Card/ Debit Card/ Net Banking/ Cash) through SBI Collect.
6.	Marks obtained in case of the application for admission in PG Courses would be considered as per B.A. / B.Sc., Part-II (Hons.) Result. One candidate may apply for PG admission without selected qualified number as mentioned above, but he/ she must have it as per Final Year (Part-III, Hons.) Result. Otherwise, he/ she will be out sided during counseling and admission.
7.	Normally 60% seats will be for the students of the Vidyasagar University and 40% seats for other Open to all.
8.	→ Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit of Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya. In the case of equal marks obtained in CET, total marks / percentage of marks of Honours is to be taken into account for ranking. In case of equal marks obtained in Honours immediately preceding Examination are to be considered for ranking.
9.	→ As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal 60% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of V.U & Autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University and 40% seats will be available for Open to all.
10.	→ The 60% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for passed out Honours students of VU & Autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University, which will be selected from the merit list of CET and the candidates have to obtain Hons marks or equivalent in the major subject.

11.	Quota for SC/ST/OBC-A&B and PH categories will be considered as per Govt. Order. Number of seats (SC-22%, ST-6%, OBC-A-10%, OBC-B-7%, PWD-3% of each categories) will be calculated and considered separately for 60% seats of V.U. students and 40% seats for Open Competition. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number.
12.	Entrance Test in each subject will be based on prescribed Under Graduate (Honours) syllabus of Vidyasagar University.
13.	Question paper of each subject contains 50 (Fifty) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ), each carrying 2 marks. Each MCQ will have 4 options.
14.	→ Duration of Entrance Exam – 1 hour.
15.	→ At the time of Entrance Examination Candidate need to carry the Admit Card of PG Entrance Examination, Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya and must bring any photo identity proof (Ex: Voter Card, Pan Card, Aadhaar Card or UG 3 rd Year Admit Card).
16.	→ Date of publication of Merit List (under both 60% & 40% category) for Open Competition: Date will be declared and available online in due time.
17.	Date of Counselling & Admission: - Date will be declared and available online in due time.
18.	All admission will be made through counselling after verification of original documents
19.	→ All admissions are provisional.
20.	→ An admission is liable to be cancelled for incorporation of incorrect data or false statements.
21.	→ All admissions will be made as per existing Reservation Policy of the State Government. The Candidates will have to produce SC/ST/OBC/PWD Certificates in original at the time of Counselling.
22.	Migration Certificate (for other university candidate only) must be submitted within two months from the date of admission.
