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Selection Process for the Admission to PG Courses in different disciplines-2018-'19

(For the Students of Vidyasagar University)

1.	➔ As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal 60% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of V.U. and 40% seats will be available for Open Competition.
2.	➔ Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit of Common Entrance Test (CET) conducted by Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya. In the case of equal marks obtained in CET, total marks / percentage of marks of Honours is to be taken into account for ranking. In case of equal marks obtained in Honours immediately preceding Examination are to be considered for ranking.
3.	➔ The students of Vidyasagar University will have to appear at Entrance Test. The minimum marks for appearing at Entrance Test is as follows: ❖ Arts: 45% marks in Honours (for General Candidates): 40% marks in Honours (For SC / ST./OBC-A/OBC-B/ PWD Candidates). ❖ Science: 50% marks in Honours (for General Candidates): 45% marks in Honours (For SC / ST/ OBC-A/OBC-B /PWD Candidates).
4.	➔ Marks obtained in case of the application for admission in PG Courses would be considered as per B.A./ B.Sc., Part-II (Hons.) Result. One candidate may apply for PG admission without selected qualified number as mentioned above, but he/ she must have it as per Final Year (Part-III, Hons.) Result. Otherwise, he/ she will be out sided during counseling and admission.
5.	➔ Quota for SC/ ST will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn / Estt dated 18.09.1997. Number of seats (SC-22%, ST-6%, OBC-A-10%, OBC-B-7%) will be calculated and considered separately for 60% seats of V.U. students and 40% seats for Open Competition. ➔ Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number. ➔ In case of non-availability of candidates of SC category, the seats reserved for SC may be converted to ST Category and vice versa. ➔ In case of non-availability of candidates of OBC-A category, the seats reserved for OBC-A may be converted to OBC-B Category and vice versa.
6.	➔ 3% of each category will be reserved for Persons with Disability (PWD) candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of PWD. In case of non-availability of PWD candidate, the seat reserved for PWD will be converted to General Category.

7.	<p>➔ Prize holders at International/National/State representation in the last two years will be considered for sports quota provided that he/she participated in the Inter College Competition/ Inter College Athletic Meet organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. The sports events are Football, Volleyball, Athletic, Joga, Khoko, Kabadi, Chess, and Table Tennis. A committee will be constituted to assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.</p>
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(Open Competition for the Students of All University)	
	➔ 40% seats in each subject are reserved for Open Competition through Common Entrance Test (CET).
	<p>➔ The students of other universities will have to appear at Entrance Test. The minimum marks for appearing at Entrance Test is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Arts: 45% marks in Honours (for General Candidates): 40% marks in Honours (For SC / ST./OBC-A/OBC-B/ PWD Candidates) ❖ Science: 50% marks in Honours (for General Candidates): 45% marks in Honours (For SC / ST/ OBC-A/OBC-B /PWD Candidates) (iii) The students of V.U. may appear at the Entrance Test & they have to secure the minimum marks as specified above.
	➔ Marks obtained in case of the application for admission in PG Courses would be considered as per B.A./ B.Sc., Part-II (Hons.) Result. One candidate may apply for PG admission without selected qualified number as mentioned above, but he/ she must have it as per Final Year (Part-III, Hons.) Result. Otherwise, he/ she will be out sided during counseling and admission.
	➔ Questions will be of MCQ pattern; Full Marks- 50; Total no. of Questions-50, Time- One and a half hour, Questions will be set in English, except in Bengali and Sanskrit.
	➔ Counseling will be held for 60% seats first and after it counseling for 40% seats will be held in the concerned department. The teachers of the concerned departments will be present at the time of counseling.
	➔ The candidates, who will get admitted under 60% seats, will not be allowed to appear at the 40% seats for Open Competition.

<i>Following documents are to be attached with the application:</i>	
	➔ Self attested photo copies of all the Mark sheets of Examination passed.
	➔ Registration Certificate and a copy of the Passport Size coloured photograph affixed on the box of the Form.
	➔ Self attested photo copy of the Admit Card/ Certificate of H.S. or equivalent/Madhyamik as evidence of the date of birth.
	➔ Self attested photo copy of SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/Persons with Disability (PWD) certificate issued by the appropriate authority, if claimed quota.
	➔ Self attested photo copies of the Certificate of Games & Sports/ Cultural Competition (International/ National/ State in the last two years), if claimed quota.
	➔ Self attested photo copy of the BPL (certificate of the parents issued by the appropriate authority, if claimed for concession of tuition fees.
	➔ Migration Certificate (for other university candidates only) must be submitted within two months from the date of admission. Application form, if not properly filled in and accompanied with attested copies of the documents as stated above, is liable to be cancelled.
	➔ All candidates are required to produce all original Certificates, Mark Sheets and testimonials for verification at the time of Counseling and admission. Candidate is to be present himself / herself for proper verification of the photograph affixed with the application form.
